- As Dormello Mo was jumping well prior to falling and has a satisfactory record no action has been taken.

### Aldous

- A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.
- Trainer S Pateman was informed the gelding would require a veterinary certificate of fitness prior to racing again.

#### Hes A Genius

- A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding sustained an abrasion to the near hind fetlock however no other significant abnormalities.
- Co-Trainers T & K OSullivan were informed the gelding would require a veterinary certificate of fitness prior to racing again.
- As He's a Genius was jumping well prior to falling and has a satisfactory record no action has been taken.

### Valediction

- A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a laceration on near hind hock.
- James Hitchcock has since spoken to the stable and advised that a veterinary clearance must be obtained.
