#### PURPOSE OF THIS FORM

This form will enable Racing Victoria to make an assessment as to whether they will issue you a Club Bookmakers Licence.

In Victoria operating as a lawful bookmaker requires a **two-step** process:

#### **1. BOOKMAKER REGISTRATION AND GUARANTEE**

A person applies to the Victorian Gambling and Casino Control Commission (VGCCC) to become "registered" as a bookmaker.

As part of that registration process, the person must have a **guarantee** which meets the requirements of section 94A of the *Racing Act 1958* (Vic).

This can be accomplished in two ways: (1) become a member of the Victorian Bookmakers' Association and contribute to their guarantee fund; (2) make alternative arrangements with the VGCCC.



#### 2. BOOKMAKER LICENCE

A registered bookmaker then applies to Racing Victoria, as a principal racing authority, to enable them to lawfully commence bookmaking operations.

- (b) a person who is or will be an executive officer, whether in right of the person or on behalf of any other person, of the Applicant's business; or
- (c) if the Applicant is a natural person, a person who is a relative of the Applicant.

## SECTION 6: PRIVACY COLLECTION STATEMENT

Racing Victoria Limited (ACN 096 917 930) (**RV**) is the Principal Racing Authority governing thoroughbred racing in Victoria, and carries out the following functions in respect of bookmakers it licenses:

- determining and issuing bookmakers' club licences;
- regulating bookmakers including monitoring compliance with licence conditions;
- monitoring bookmakers and betting transactions;
- ensuring the integrity and probity of bookmaking businesses; and
- ensuring the efficient operation of bookmaking services.

RV is collecting your personal information on this form, including your name, contact details and financial information. We may also be collecting personal information about you which may be considered sensitive or protected under applicable laws (such information may include your criminal record (including pending civil or criminal proceedings or charges)) that you may provide in this form or under your ongoing disclosure obligations.

The purpose of collecting your personal information is for our legitimate interests, including as required pursuant to the Racing Victoria Rules of Racing (including the Rules of Race Betting) (**Rules of Racing**), the *Club Bookmakers' Licence Rules 2010, Bookmakers' Levy Rules 2012, Bookmakers' Telephone Betting Rules 2001, Bookmakers' Internet Betting Rules 2001, Bookmaker Sports Betting Rules 2007* and any other rules made under the *Racing Act 1958* (Vic) (together the **Bookmaker Rules**), which require RV to collect information about bookmakers and betting transactions. Further, the collection of your personal information allows RV to perform its regulatory functions, including but not limited to:

- make determinations in relation to your licence application, renewal or continuance;
- to verify your compliance with the Rules of Racing, the Bookmaker Rules and any conditions imposed on your Licence;
- to detect breach of and/or non-compliance with the Rules of Racing, Bookmaker Rules and any conditions imposed on your Licence;
- to investigate possible or suspected breaches and/or instances of non-compliance of the Rules of Racing, Bookmaker Rules and any conditions imposed on your Licence; and
- to otherwise meet its regulatory responsibilities in relation to you as a bookmaker (together, RV's **Regulatory Purpose**).

If your personal information is not collected, either on this form or otherwise when requested by RV as part of its licensing and regulatory activities, we may not be able to process your application (and therefore refuse to grant your application or renew your licence, as the case may be) or may revoke or suspend your licence.

To further its Regulatory Purpose, RV may also obtain personal (including sensitive) information about you from, or disclose your personal information to, third parties such as:

- entities set out in section 91E of the Racing Act 1958 (Vic);
- enforcement bodies (as defined in section 6 of the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth));
- Federal or state government authorities (for example, the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation);

- racing control bodies (such as other PRA's and their equivalents in Greyhound and Harness) in the States and Territories of Australia and overseas;
- racing clubs;
- approved system providers, contractors and/or other service providers;
- wagering service providers; and
- the Victorian Bookmakers' Association Ltd.

### SECTION 7: PROVISION OF BETTING RECORDS

In order for RV to fulfil the Functions and Purpose described in <u>SECTION 6</u> of this Application Form, Rule 13.11.2 of the *Club Bookmaker's Licence Rules 2010* (**Club Bookmakers Licence Rules**), a bookmaker must provide as directed by RV, all information, records or documents required by RV to verify the bookmaker's obligations under and compliance with the Bookmaker Rules and Rules of Racing made under the *Racing Act 1958* (Vic) and any relevant law, including without limitation; information regarding bets made by the bookmaker (**Betting Records**). Such Betting Records are to be provided in the form and manner as may be required by the Authorised Officer (as defined in the Club Bookmaker's Licence Rules).

In addition to ensuring compliance with the Club Bookmakers Licence Rules, Rules of Racing, and the Bookmaker Rules (as defined in <u>SECTION 6</u> of this Application Form and amended from time to time) and any relevant law, this information may be used for reporting purposes.

RV may disclose Betting Records to third parties such as:

- entities set out in section 91E of the Racing Act 1958 (Vic);
- enforcement bodies (as defined in section 6 of the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth));
- Federal or state government authorities (for example, the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation);
- racing control bodies (such as other PRA's and their equivalents in Greyhound and Harness) in the States and Territories of Australia and overseas;
- racing clubs;
- approved system providers, contractors and/or other service providers;
- wagering service providers; and
- the Victorian Bookmakers' Association Ltd.

- (f) agree to be subject and bound by such rules and directions as may from time to time be made or given by the directors of Racing Victoria, Authorised Officers of Racing Victoria, the Stewards and/or betting supervisors of Racing Victoria (or any of their delegates), or any officials of any racing club registered to conduct thoroughbred racing under the Rules of Racing;
- (g) acknowledge that, when one of our Key Employees is performing the role of Approved Substitute for us, that person carries on our bookmaking business on our behalf and we are liable for the operation of that business at all times;
- (h) acknowledge that we have read and agree to be bound by the Privacy Collection Statement in <u>SECTION 6</u> and the Provision of Betting Records in <u>SECTION 7</u> of this Application Form;
- agree to be bound by Racing Victoria policies relating to bookmakers, including but not limited to the stand allocation policies, which may be amended from time to time;
- (j) agree to use an Approved Betting System (ABS) to record all betting activity, in accordance with Rule 13 of the Club Bookmakers Licence Rules;
- (k) agree that when using an ABS, it is our responsibility to:
  - conduct our own due diligence regarding the ABS provider and suitability of the ABS to our business requirements and circumstances; and
  - (ii) ensure that we are satisfied with the commercial terms offered by the ABS provider - including the level of insurance cover held by the ABS provider - are appropriate and sufficient for our requirements and circumstances;

- (I) agree to have all outstanding payments owed to Racing Victoria (including any administrative charges, levy fees or fines) settled by the commencement of the new licence period on 1 August 2023;
- (m) in addition to the Financial Statement provided, we warrant that my/our bookmaking business has sufficient funds and/or resources available to maintain and manage the business the subject of this application and that there is no insolvency event or similar proceeding on foot now or likely to be in the foreseeable future that may have a material affect on my/our capacity to be a bookmaker;
- (n) agree to ensure all required end of day files are transferred to Racing Victoria at the conclusion of each day of operation;
- (o) declare that we are not financially or in any other way interested in illegal betting whatsoever, and we undertake that we will not engage or attempt to engage in any such business while we hold a Club Bookmaker's Licence issued by Racing Victoria;
- (p) declare that my terms and conditions and betting rules comply with all applicable laws;
- (q) agree to insert the prescribed wording contained in <u>SECTION 8</u> of this Application Form into my/our privacy policy and/or information collection statement or otherwise use language provided by me/us, subject to the approval of Racing Victoria;
- (r) agree that Racing Victoria is able to supply, and otherwise consent to Racing Victoria supplying, customer's personal information and/or betting records to a third-party service provider for the strict purpose of assisting Racing Victoria fulfill its regulatory functions in accordance with section 91E of the Racing Act or otherwise permitted by law;
- (s) acknowledge and confirm that, pursuant to the requirements of the Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing Act 2006 (Cth) ('AML/CTF Act'), we are enrolled with the Australian Transaction Reports and Analysis Centre ('AUSTRAC') and warrant that we are/our business is (and will continue to be throughout the period of the Club Bookmaker's Licence) compliant with our / its obligations under the AML/CTF Act;<sup>1</sup>
- (t) warrant that as at the date of signing this declaration and at all times during the period of my Club Bookmakers Licence neither we nor our bookmaking business is in breach or contravention of or default under or non-compliance with any statute, rule, regulation or by-law whether Commonwealth or State that is related to or in connection with wagering or the activities or undertakings of operating a wagering business or the breach of which would constitute a criminal offence and neither we nor our bookmaking business has received notice that it may be in such default, contravention or breach. Please note this does not only include wagering specific statutes, rules, regulations or by-laws but also other such provisions that cover our bookmaking operations generally, including (but not limited to) the Australian Consumer Law;
- (u) warrant that I will promptly abide by any and all taxation laws, ruling, investigations or otherwise and provide full cooperation with the Australian Taxation Office ('ATO') in association with the taxation responsibilities, debts or otherwise that may result as a consequence or in association with my/our bookmaking business;
