



Team Talk Tips

Use these handy phrases when talking to your team.

- Racing Victoria has developed a new learning portal to provide you with online training
- The training is designed to help improve everyone's conduct in the racing industry and our understanding of the Rules of Racing
- The first course focuses on horse welfare before, during and after racing
- You **MUST** complete the course before renewing or obtaining a new licence. Don't leave it until the last minute, set aside some time soon after you get the email from RV
- It takes around 30 minutes to complete
- To get started you'll receive a 'Welcome' email with your learning portal username in it, use this to get into the site
- To start the first course, find it on the portal home page or you'll get another email with a link to the course – click on it
- The email address you have registered with RV is where you'll find any messages from them
- Do it on a computer for the best experience, or a smartphone or tablet if you have one (*Tip: offer them the use of a 'spare' computer if there's one available or access to Wi-Fi*)
- Pre-trainers, trainers, jockeys, farriers, float drivers, rider agents, stable hands and RV staff will do the training across the remainder of the 2020-21 racing season
- Other courses will be introduced in the 2021-22 racing season
- If you need help, there's step-by-step guides I can give you, or find them [*in the kitchen, change room, on the notice board*]. You can also email or call RV for assistance
