APPEAL DECISION

JACK MARTIN and RACING VICTORIA STEWARDS

Date of Hearing: 31 July 2017

Heard By: Brian Forrest (Deputy Chair)

Appearances: Rob Montgomery appeared on behalf of the stewards.

Des O'Keeffe appeared on behalf of Mr Martin.

At Sandown Park Hillside on Wednesday 26 July 2017, apprentice jockey Jack Martin pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding on his mount *White Devon* in Race 7 the *Ladbrokes Odds Boost Multi Handicap* (1600m).

The carelessness being that passing the 1100m, he permitted his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of *All Day Every Day* which had to be steadied.

Mr Martin had his permit to ride in races suspended for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday, 29 July 2017 and to expire at midnight on Sunday, 6 August 2017 – a total of 8 race meetings (2 metro, 6 provincial).

In assessing penalty Stewards took into account his guilty plea and good record and that the carelessness was in the low range.

A Notice of Appeal against the severity of the penalty was lodged on Thursday, 27 July 2017. A stay of proceedings was not requested.

DECISION: Appeal allowed.

Penalty varied so that the period of suspension expires at midnight on Friday, 4 August 2017 (6 race meetings).

It is perhaps in all the circumstances slightly excessive. I would vary the penalty to six meetings, expiring on Friday, 9 August 2017.
