At Ballarat on Tuesday 15 March 2016, jockey Brad Rawiller was fined $\$ 400$ for a breach of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) which states that:

AR 137A(5) - Subject to the other requirements of this rule: (a) In a race, official trial or jump-out prior to the 100 metre mark; (ii) the whip shall not be used on more than 5 occasions.

The particulars of the charge being that Mr Rawiller used his whip 7 times prior to the 100 metre mark on his mount Proclamation in Race 6 the Hygain BM64 Handicap (2200m).

In assessing penalty Stewards took into account Mr Rawiller's good record.
A Notice of Appeal against the severity of the penalty was lodged on Thursday, 17 March 2016.

## DECISION: Appeal dismissed. <br> Penalty to remain standing.
