At Geelong Synthetic on Friday 28 August 2015, jockey Andrew Mallyon was found guilty of a charge of careless riding on his mount *Dubyago* in Race 6 the *National Heating and Cooling BM64 Handicap*.

The careless riding being that approaching the 1000 metres he carelessly permitted his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of *Futures*, which was steadied and carried in across the running of *Rearview*, resulting in *Rearview* being checked.

Mr Mallyon had his licence to ride in races suspended for a period to commence at midnight on Tuesday, 1 September 2015 and to expire at midnight on Thursday, 10 September 2015 – a total of 9 race meetings (2 metro, 7 provincial.)

In assessing penalty the Stewards were of the view that the incident qualified for the low range category of carelessness and took into account his record and personal circumstances.

A Notice of Appeal against **the decision and severity of the penalty** was lodged on Monday, 31 August 2015. A stay of proceedings was not requested.

**DECISION:** **Appeal dismissed. Penalty to remain standing.**
