SUBJECT : APPEAL HEARING RESULT: JOCKEY – DANIEL MOOR

At Sandown Lakeside on Wednesday 11th February 2009, jockey Daniel Moor was found guilty of a charge of careless riding (AR 137a) on his mount *Hydra* in Race 7 the *Nizam's Ring Handicap* (1400m).

The careless riding being that shortly after the start he permitted his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of *Port Isabel* resulting in that mare being taken in onto *Carrigan* resulting in *Carrigan* being taken in off its course and *Port Isabel* having to be checked. Daniel Moor had his licence to ride in races suspended for a period to commence midnight Friday 13th February 2009 and to expire midnight Friday 20th February 2009, a total of 8 race meetings (2 city, 6 country).

A Notice of Appeal against **the decision and the severity of the penalty** was lodged on Thursday 12th February 2009.

A stay of proceedings was granted effective until midnight Monday 16th February 2009.

DECISION: Appeal dismissed.

Penalty varied – suspension to now expire midnight Saturday 21st February 2009.
