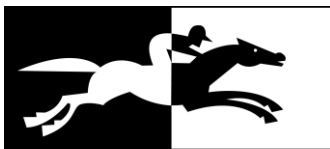

SUBJECT: **APPEAL HEARING RESULT – JOCKEY: GLYN SCHOFIELD**

Appearances Mr Des O’Keeffe, Chief Executive VJA, appeared on behalf of Mr Schofield.
Mr Terry Bailey, Chairman of Stewards, appeared on behalf of the Stewards.

At Flemington on Saturday 30 October 2010, jockey Glyn Schofield pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding on his mount *Quick Peek* in Race 8 the *Seppelt Salinger Stakes* (Group 2, 1200m).

The careless riding being that after passing the 200m he permitted his mount to shift out, whilst riding along, and in doing so was insufficiently clear of *Dorf Command* resulting in *Dorf Command* having to be eased to avoid his heels and also resulted in *Swift Alliance* being hampered.

Glyn Schofield had his licence to ride in races suspended for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday, 30 October 2010 and to expire at midnight on Saturday, 6 November 2010 - a total of 7 race meetings (2 metropolitan, 5 country). In assessing penalty Stewards took into account the careless riding was in the low range category.

A Notice of Appeal against **the severity of the penalty** was lodged on Sunday, 31 October 2010. A stay of proceedings was not requested.

DECISION: **Appeal allowed.**

Period of suspension to now expire at midnight on Friday, 5 November 2010 (6 race meetings).
