PANEL'S COMMENTS

- All horses competing in Races 1 and 2 underwent veterinary examinations after arriving on course and were passed suitable to race.
- A post race veterinary examination of King Triton failed to reveal any abnormalities.

- Jockey Gavin Bedggood was examined by the doctor and passed fit.
- No action has been taken against King Triton as the horse was jumping well prior to the third obstacle. The Panel will continue to monitor King Triton's performances.
- A post race veterinary examination of Sparton failed to reveal any abnormalities other than a slower than normal recovery.
- Tom Ryan was examined by the doctor and passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagement.
- No action has been taken against Sparton as the horse was jumping well prior to the third obstacle. The Panel will continue to monitor Sparton's performances.
- A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.
- Trainer Todd Balfour advised the Panel Chapare has been retired from racing.
