PANEL'S COMMENTS

• ZANTECO:

- A post-race Veterinary examination revealed a small amount of blood from the left nostril, however no other abnormalities.
- Further the Veterinary surgeon was satisfied that the blood was a result of external trauma and therefore Zanteco was not deemed to be a one nostril bleeder.-
- No action has been taken against Zanteco as the Panel believe the gelding was jumping satisfactorily and fell as a result of over racing leading into the eighth.
- The Weir stable were advised that prior to racing again, the gelding would require a veterinary certificate of clearance.
