

PANEL'S COMMENTS

- A post-race veterinary examination revealed Coogan to be lame in the off fore. Trainer Dan O'Sullivan was notified that he will be required to provide a veterinary clearance before the horse is accepted to race again.
- No action has been taken against Coogan. This was Coogan's first start in a jumps race and was found to be lame. A vet certificate must be produced next start and future jumps performances will be monitored.
