- A post-race veterinary examination of Tramcar Johnny revealed the gelding to be lame in the right fore leg, to be experiencing a slow recovery and having been galloped on the left fore leg. Trainer Dan O'Sullivan was advised he would be required to submit a veterinary certificate of fitness before the gelding is next presented to race.
- Tramcar Johnny is required to trial to the satisfaction of the Panel over a distance of at least 2400m prior to accepting in future jumps races.
