

JRP FURTHER COMMENTS

• Fionn McCool

- A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg; treatment was administered on course and the gelding will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.
- Connections advised Stewards Fionn McCool has been retired from racing.

• Mr Schiller

- Must trial over a distance of at least 2800m prior to accepting in future jumps races.

• Jacks n Kings

- A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had sustained abrasions to its near fore pastern, a cut to its near fore fetlock and had lost its near hind plate.
- No action has been taken against Jacks 'n' Kings however a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing or trialling.

- Connections advised Polixenis Boy would now be sent for a spell.
- Polixenis Boy is required to trial prior to accepting in future jumps races.

- A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.
- Connections advised Arribos has now been retired from racing.
