<u>Charge 1</u> AR 175(h)(i) - Administration of a prohibited substance for the

purpose of affecting the performance or behaviour of a horse in

a race. Withdrawn

<u>Charge 2</u> AR 175(h)(ii) – [Alternative to Charge 1]

The Principal Racing Authority (or the Stewards exercising

powers delegated to them) may penalise:

(h) Any person who administers, or causes to be administered, to a horse any prohibited substance:

(ii) which is detected in any sample taken from such horse

prior to or following the running of any race.

<u>Summary</u> The Stewards allege that prior to the race on 29 June 2016, Ms

Croston administered, or caused to be administered, to Hezza

Tidal Wave a prohibited substance being cobalt at a

concentration in excess of 200 micrograms per litre in urine which was detected in a urine sample taken from *Hezza Tidal*

Wave prior to the running of the race.

<u>Charge 3</u> AR 178 [Alternative to Charges 1 and 2] - Presentation of a

horse to race with a prohibited substance.

Falls Away

Plea Charge 1 Withdrawn

Charge 2 Guilty
Charge 3 Falls away

<u>Penalty</u> Ms Croston is suspended for a period of four months.

In accordance with AR 177, Hezza Tidal Wave is disqualified from Race 5 at Sandown racecourse on 29 June 2016 and the places

amended accordingly.
