At Kilmore on Monday 29 September 2014, jockey John Keating was found guilty of a charge of careless riding on his mount Sharknado in Race 2 the Costanzo Automotive Repairs Wandong 3 YO F Maiden Plate (1107m).

The careless riding being that he allowed his mount to shift in near the 700 metres when insufficiently clear of Social Media resulting in that mare having to be checked and lose its position.

Mr Keating had his licence to ride in races suspended for a period to commence at midnight on Tuesday, 30 September 2014 and to expire at midnight on Friday, 10 October 2014 - a total of 12 race meetings (3 city, 9 provincial).

In assessing penalty Stewards deemed the incident to be in the mid range and took into account his record in this area.

A Notice of Appeal against the decision and severity of the penalty was lodged on Wednesday, 1 October 2014.

An application for leave to withdraw the appeal against decision was accepted by the Board at the hearing.

DECISION: Appeal against severity of penalty allowed.
Taking into account the stay of proceedings, penalty varied so that the period of suspension will now expire at midnight on Saturday, 11 October 2014.
